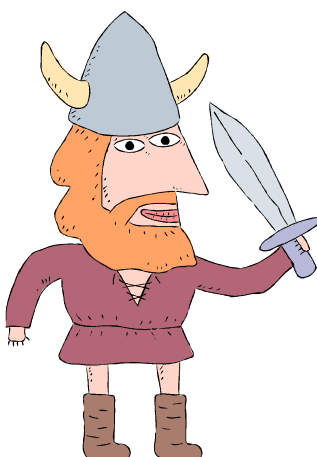

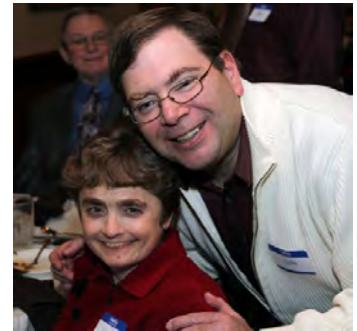


fun and made some serious money for our councils and Assembly.
